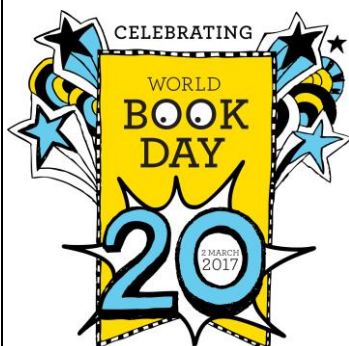
Health and Sport Day at Howes
