Welcome to Nursery. We have lots of exciting things happening this term and are going to be very busy with a wide range of learning opportunities - read on to find out more!

Our topic this half term is 'All about me.' We will be learning all about ourselves, our new friends and teachers, as well as the nursery routines.



In Nursery we really emphasise the importance of reading with your child. So from after October half term we will start our 'Reading Mornings' where Mums, Dads, Grandparents or any other family can come into class first thing in the morning to share a book with your child and their friends. This will then happen every Wednesday starting from 4th November.
