On Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May Year 5 pupils will be visiting Safeside in Birmingham. Safeside is an experiential learning centre that provides an opportunity for children to think about how they can keep themselves safe in a variety of settings. This is an important part of our PSHE curriculum.

There is a full-sized street scene that includes a working pedestrian crossing, double decker bus, building society branch, shop, car, canal, court room, police station, house and much more. We will leave school at 8:15am and return at 4pm (depending on traffic). Children will need a packed lunch. Some of the activities are outside so children should bring a coat and wear suitable shoes.
