KS1 Visit to Warwick Castle - Tuesday 17th January

Dear Parents,

After careful consideration, we have decided to go ahead with our planned visit to Warwick Castle despite not having received all of the necessary permission slips for either Year 1 or Year 2. Please could any outstanding permission slips be in school by the end of this week as without your permission we cannot take your child out of school.

Voluntary contributions can be paid by either cash or cheque at the school office or by using our online payment system SIMSAGORA. Whatever contribution you are able to make will help us to cover cost of the trip.

As mentioned in my previous letter, **we shall be leaving school at 9.00am promptly (or as soon as the coach arrives) on Tuesday morning and will be back by the end of the school day.** The children will need to come to school in school uniform (including trousers/ PE jogging bottoms), wearing comfortable walking shoes and a warm, waterproof coat. We will be outside for a good portion of the day and they should dress with this in mind as it could be cold (gloves and a scarf/ hat could be useful too!).

They should bring with them a packed lunch (including a drink in a plastic bottle) which should be carried in a small bag/ backpack. Pupils will be responsible for their own bags throughout the day.

Please note even if you have opted for a school packed lunch for your child they will still need a small bag/ backpack to carry it in.

If your child suffers from travel sickness or needs any other medication throughout the day can you please ensure that staff are aware of this and that they have taken travel sickness remedies (if appropriate) before coming to school on this day. Any medication that we already have in school for your child such as inhalers etc we will ensure we take with us on the day.

We do feel that this day will be a really valuable and enjoyable launch to our 'Towers, Tunnels and Turrets' topic and I am sure we will have a fantastic day next Tuesday! ☺
