

Medication

We can only allow children to have medication in school if you have completed a medical form giving written permission, clearly stating the dosage to be given. 'Medication' covers anything from throat sweets, to cream, to an inhaler or a JEXT/ Epi pen.

All medication must be provided in its original packaging and clearly labelled. All medication will be stored safely within school. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure that all medication is in date.

Please can we remind all families that due to potentially life threatening conditions, Howes is a NUT FREE school.

A message from the School Nursing Team

#### **Hearing Screening for Reception Aged Children**

If you have concerns about your child's hearing you can book them in to one of our hearing screening clinics. The screening will be carried out by trained members of our school nursing team. If your child is identified as having a hearing problem, they will be referred to the City of Coventry Health Centre for a further hearing test.

Signs of a possible hearing problem can include:

- Inattentiveness or poor concentration
- $\bullet$  Not responding when their name is called
- Talking loudly and listening to the television at a high volume
- Difficulty pinpointing where a sound is coming from
- Mispronouncing words
- · A change in their progress at school

If you're child has problems with any of these and you wish your child's hearing to be screened then please contact your school nurse team.
