A message from the Governing Body

Governors wanted to formally let you all know that the LA have now officially opened a consultation for the 2023 admissions policy from 30.11.21 regarding the Pupil Admission Number reduction for Howes Primary School. We need to ensure that as a school we pass information through our local community networks and have this on our website. Additional documents to the declining birth rates are attached to the survey so that members of the public can see the reasons for the reduction as well as the admissions policy.

Primary Consultation 2023 Admissions Policy

Coventry City Council is proposing to reduce the Published Admissions Number for the community primary schools as listed below starting in September 2023.

School Name	Current Number	Proposed Number
Howes Primary	30	15

The reduction will apply to Reception in 2023 and for each year after this. The size of all higher year groups in the school are expected to remain unchanged whilst children progress through the school.

Schools, parents of children between the ages of 2 and 18, residents and other members of the public will have the opportunity to have their say on these proposed changes between **30**th **November 2021 – 11**th **January 2022.**

You are invited to make comment on the proposed changes to this policy. Your views are important to us.
